
I am writing to express support by Bose Corporation for the U.S.-Korea Free Trade Agreement, the U.S.-Panama Trade Promotion Agreement, and the U.S.-Colombia Trade Promotion Agreement. We are very grateful to you and your teams for your work on these free trade agreements and urge the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative and the Administration to make every effort towards early Congressional approval.

Bose Corporation engineers, manufactures, and distributes electronics and audio equipment. We have over 3,400 employees in operations in Framingham, Westboro and Stow, Massachusetts, Columbia, South Carolina, and Yuma, Arizona. The value of Bose Corporation export sales to these countries is approximately \$7.0 million to Korea, \$7.6 million to Panama, and \$164,000 to Colombia. However, we anticipate increases in export sales to these countries following implementation of the free trade agreements as the negotiated, bound rates would bring most tariffs to zero.

Thank you again for your hard work on negotiating and seeking implementation of these free trade agreements.
