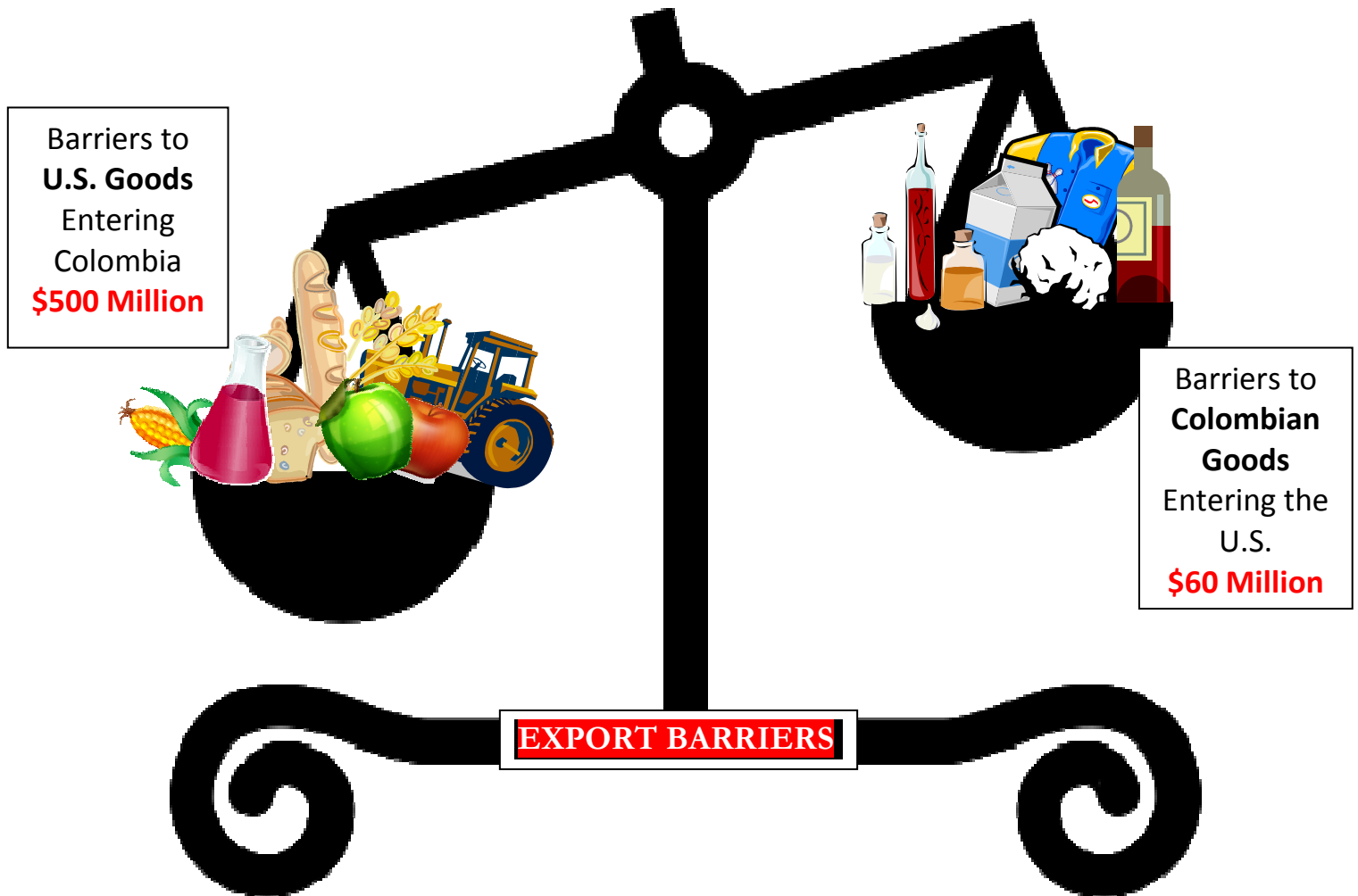


# THE COLOMBIA TRADE PROMOTION AGREEMENT

In 2007, American goods such as wheat, apples, corn, tractors and scientific equipment faced nearly \$500 million in unfair trade barriers when entering Colombia, while Colombian goods faced only \$60 million when entering the United States. Over 90% of imports from Colombia already enter the U.S. duty-free. That's a trade relationship that's out of balance.

It's time to give American goods, more than \$6.7 billion in top exports, and the workers who are responsible for their production, duty-free access to the Colombian market.
