Chrysler, Ford and General Motors Support US-Colombia Free Trade Agreement

WASHINGTON — The Automotive Trade Policy Council (ATPC) and its member companies — Chrysler LLC, Ford Motor Company, and General Motors Corporation — support and encourage Congressional approval of the US-Colombia Free Trade Agreement.
