



## Cisco Welcomes Congressional Action on Free Trade

Cisco welcomes Senate Finance Committee Chairman Max Baucus' (D-MT) [announcement](#) yesterday that the Committee intends to move legislation to implement pending U.S. free trade agreements with South Korea, Colombia and Panama, as well as to renew Trade Adjustment Assistance. Cisco also appreciates the bipartisan approach taken by Committee's Ranking Member Orin Hatch (R-UT), who has been instrumental in helping build consensus and create momentum in Congress to pass these agreements.
