



## LATIN AMERICA TRADE COALITION

Dear members of the United States Congress:

On behalf of the Latin America Trade Coalition — a broad-based group of more than 500 U.S. companies, business associations, and chambers of commerce — we are writing to urge approval of the trade promotion agreements with Peru, Colombia, and Panama this year. We applaud the bipartisan trade framework reached a few weeks ago by the leaders of the House Ways and Means and Senate Finance committees and the Administration. Thanks to this breakthrough, we understand that the agreement with Peru may be submitted to the Congress for consideration very shortly, and we are pressing for the other two accords to be submitted soon. Both the economic interests and national security of the United States will be advanced by a closer partnership with these countries, whose dynamic economies and moderate politics recommend them as friends, allies, and partners.

Remarkably, U.S. trade with Peru, Colombia, and Panama has nearly doubled over the past four years. Two-way commerce reached \$27.9 billion in 2006. More than 8,384 U.S. companies export their products to Colombia; 5,610 to Panama; and 5,519 to Peru. Of this total, over 80% were small and medium-sized companies. U.S. farmers and ranchers sell over a billion dollars worth of agricultural products to these markets, and U.S. manufacturers are enjoying double-digit sales growth. In other words, trade with these countries is already bringing benefits to tens of thousands of Americans.

While trade is already booming with these economies, U.S. exporters will benefit significantly from the new market openings created by these agreements. Simply put, these trade accords will create a level playing field for American workers, farmers, and companies. Years ago, the United States unilaterally opened its markets to most imports from Peru, Colombia, and Panama through trade preference bills. As a result, more than 90% of all imports from these countries already enter the U.S. marketplace duty-free. By contrast, the U.S. International Trade Commission (USITC) reports that “most of Peru’s average tariff rates range from 12% to 25%,” with similar figures for Colombia and Panama. In other words, these three countries enjoy nearly free access to our marketplace while our access to theirs remains limited.

These trade agreements will fix this imbalance by forging a mutually beneficial, reciprocal partnership. Four-fifths of U.S. consumer and industrial products and most U.S. farm exports will enter Peru, Colombia, and Panama duty-free immediately upon implementation of the agreements. The USITC estimates

U.S. exports to Peru and Colombia will increase by \$1.1 billion each — for a total of \$2.2 billion in new U.S. exports — upon implementation of the agreements. (The USITC’s Panama report should be released by September 12.)

In addition to these direct economic benefits for Americans, the national security interests of the United States will be advanced through these agreements. They will help strengthen democratic institutions while lending support for the rule of law, transparency in business and government, protection of intellectual property, and internationally recognized worker rights. They will provide local citizens with long-term alternatives to narcotics trafficking or illegal immigration.

As the first of the three agreements to be concluded and signed, the agreement with Peru is likely to be considered first by Congress. It’s impressive to note that U.S. companies employ over 100,000 Peruvians directly and generate at least three times as many jobs indirectly. Peruvian exports to the United States support an additional 800,000 jobs. This figure represents more than one-quarter of Peru’s formal sector employment, underscoring how economic ties to the United States are providing Peruvians with critically needed jobs, income, and tax revenues. All told, approximately two million jobs in Peru, Colombia, and Panama depend on expanding trade with the United States. Extending tariff preferences for these countries, now set to expire in less than a month, will help avoid trade disruption and job loss pending entry-into-force of the agreements. However, in the long run, the preferences are not an alternative to the trade promotion agreements.

At a time when leaders in some South American countries are using anti-American rhetoric, the elected leaders of Peru, Colombia, and Panama are staunch allies of the United States who deserve our support. They are embracing pragmatic policies, the rule of law, and partnership with the United States. Approving these win-win agreements will lend Peruvians, Colombians, and Panamanians a helping hand and advance the national interest of the United States. We urge you to cast a favorable vote for the trade promotion agreements with Peru, Colombia, and Panama.
